A Flight Training Affiliate (FTA) is a contracted, FAA Part 141, flight training provider for Liberty University School of Aeronautics. Students enrolled at an FTA can complete their Bachelor of Science in Aeronautics online in approximately 2.5 years. Students who participate in the school's dual enrollment program may finish the program in less time.

UNIQUE BENEFITS

- » For eligible recipients of the Post-9/11 GI Bill®, books, written exams, headsets, charts, and check ride costs could be covered.
